



Good Governance for all: Focus on effective administration

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Enquiry Commission:

• We will set up a committee of a Retired High Court Judge to investigate various projects commissioned in the name of development that include but not limited to Kaleshwaram, Dharani, Mission Bhagiratha that have seen huge cost escalations and corruption. We will publish a white paper on the corruption that has taken place in the name of development in various projects and blacklist contractors that were a part of this organised plunder. All corruption charges will be investigated and concerned contractors will be blacklisted.

Scrutiny Mechanism:

 We will set up a special mechanism to scrutinise illegal land allocations, including encroachment of temple lands and land auctions that took place during the last 10 years and ensure that injustices meted out are redressed.

Nehru Outer Ring Road:

 We will investigate the Toll, Operate and Transfer (TOT) bidding process in the Nehru Outer Ring Road project and ensure that the bid award is renegotiated.

Abolish Dharani:

 We will abolish the Dharani system which is leading to an organised land mafia taking over farmers' land. We will come up with a foolproof system, mee-Bhoomi.

Multi-channel Corruption Help-line:

 For a corruption free-state, we will set-up a multichannel system (internet, help-line and physical locations) at various levels from Panchayat to Secretariat to record complaints on corruption and ensure that a dedicated legal and law enforcement team will pursue it in a stipulated time frame.

Welfare of Employees and Pensions

Pay Revision Commission (PRC):

We will ensure the implementation of a regular Pay Revision Commission (PRC) for state government employees. Going forward, we pledge to announce PRC revisions every 5 years to ensure regular and equitable adjustments. Dearness Allowance and Interim Relief will be given on-time.

Timely Salaries:

 We will ensure timely payment of salaries to employees. On the 1st of every month, salaries will be deposited into the employees' bank accounts.

Validity of Employee Health Cards:

The current State
Government has betrayed
employees as many
hospitals do not honour the
health cards as the state
government does not
reimburse expenses and
bills on time. We will
revamp the system to
benefit employees.

Zonal System of Transfers:

 We will ensure that there will be regular promotions and transfers. We will relook at GO 317 in consultation with all stakeholders.

Contract Employee issues:

 We will set up a committee to scrutinise the issues faced by Contract teachers, ASHA & ANM Workers, Arogya Sri Workers, Home Guards, Indira Kranthi Pathakam (IKP) and other out-sourced employees to arrive at a reasonable solution.

Predictability in Pension Payments:

 We will ensure that the beneficiaries' bank accounts will be credited with pension payments on the first day of every month.



Welfare of Overseas and Gulf Telugu Residents

Separate department/ministry for Overseas Residents:

 We will ensure that the beneficiaries' bank accounts will be credited with pension payments on the first day of every month.

Set-up of Telangana Bhavans in Gulf Countries:

 BJP on assuming power in Telangana will evaluate the set-up of Telangana Bhavans in Gulf Countries for the welfare of Telugu people. This will be done in consultation with the Govt of India.

Health care assistance through Teleconsultation:

 BJP will operationalise teleconsultation with doctors for Gulf residents through esanjeevani, to avail of medical advice from doctors free of cost.



Reduce Petrol prices and Diesel prices in Telangana:

State Capital Region:

 We will extend the Aspirational Mandal Programme to 100 new Mandals and ensure their holistic development.


CM Dashboard:

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Empowering the marginalised communities: Equality before the law

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Telangana's first Chief Minister from Backward Community:

 Channelizing the aspirations of the marginalised sections and providing real social justice and to take care of all the people and ensure their development, BJP will appoint Telangana's first BC Chief Minister.

Removing religion based reservations:

 We are committed to remove the unconstitutional religion based reservations in the state and reallocate it to Backward Castes (Bcs), Scheduled Castes (SCs) and Scheduled Tribes (STs) commensurate with their population.

Special BC Development Fund:

To ensure the development and welfare of Backward classes in the state of Telanganawewillensurethat:

- State BC Commission to be given appropriate statutory backing.
- Pensions for all artisans listed in the PM Vishwa karma Yojana on the lines of Atal Pension Yojana.
- Extension of ESI facilities to Utpatti Kulalu involved in production activities and intense labour oriented works.
- MBC Corporation will be revamped to guide, train, skill and finance.
- Support Creation of BC CCI (Backward Classes Chamber of Commerce and Industry) to enable the creation of more selfemployment opportunities.

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Saturation of PM Vishwakarma Yojana:

 The PM Viswakarma Yojana will be implemented with an aim to reach maximum saturation. BJP will ensure that all 18 vocational trades that include but are not limited to carpenters, tailors, potters, masons, barbers, washermen and others can seamlessly avail of the scheme.

Marriage Function Halls:

 Marriage function halls will be constructed in every mandal and will be handed over for professional management.

Welfare of microcommunities:

 The aspirations of several castes and microcommunities across the spectrum from Vulnerable tribal groups such as Chenchus to Arya Vysyas who have been neglected due to small percentage of population will be protected.



Increase ST Reservations commensurate with percentage:

 We will ensure that the reservation provided for SCs & STs is commensurate with the population after the creation of Telangana.

SC Sub categorisation:

 BJP in Telangana will work with the Union Government to fast track SC sub categorisation in reservations to ensure that the most disadvantaged and underprivileged among the SCs are empowered.

Path to Entrepreneurship for Safai Karamcharis:

 Safai Karamcharis will be co-owners of the waste management system on the lines of Indore like successfulcities.

Filling up backlogs in Government:

 We will fast track filling up of vacancies of the SC and Sts.



Social Welfare for specific Professions

Welfare of Beedi workers:

 Beedi workers will be provided social security.

Welfare of Gig Workers:

 We will set up Telangana Gig Workers Welfare Board for the empowerment and upliftment of 5 lakh gig workers and ensure they benefit from all central government social security schemes.

Welfare of Migrant Labour:

 We will set up Migrant Labour Welfare Board, to ensure swift resolution of grievances for all Telangana residents migrating to other states. We will provide low-cost loans of up to ₹1 lakhs for women family members of the migrant labourers to promote incomegenerating activities.

Welfare for Lawyers:

- BJP will ensure the welfare of the lawyers by bringing in the Lawyers' Protection Act to prevent arbitrary attacks on the advocates by both state and non-state players and other required measures.
- BJP will transfer the existing Rs.100 crore fund given to Telangana Advocates Trust to the Bar Council of Telangana and will add another Rs.200 crores to make it a Rs. 300 crore corpus.



Welfare of Singareni Employees

Wages for Contract Workers in the Collieries:

 We will increase the wages of contract workers of Singareni Collieries at par with Coal India.

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Making Singareni one of the leading PSU in the country:

 We will actively work on acquiring coal blocks in Telangana and other states by participating in the auction process conducted by the Coal Ministry.

Income Tax reimbursement for Singareni employees:

 BJP on assuming office, will reimburse income tax of Singareni Collieries employees.



Vayo Ashrams:

 We will leverage on the Government of India scheme of Atal Vayo Abhyuday Yojana (AVYAY) to build Vayo Ashrams (Old Age Homes) with good infrastructure facility, walking spaces, green cover and parks and 24X7 medical facilities.

Ram Mandir and Kashi Yatra:

 In due consideration of the fruition of a 550-year-long wait of the unveiling of a Grand Ram Mandir in A y o d h y a a n d t h e rejuvenation of Kashi after more than 240 years, BJP on assuming office will organise free Ram Mandir and Kashi Yatras for Senior Citizens.

Assistance for Specially abled:

 We will provide collateralfree loans of up to ₹25 lakh at a minimal interest rate to persons with disabilities for employment and selfemployment opportunities.



Law and order

Hyderabad has become a hub for religion based radicalisation and illegal immigration. Many terrorist operations and activities have linkages to Hyderabad and to counter this, BJP promises the following:

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Anti-Radicalisation Cell:

- We will create an Anti-Radicalization Cell to identify and eliminate potential threats, and sleeper cells of terrorist organisations and anti-Indiaforces.
- Police stations where there have been instances of radicalization in the past will be operated by specially trained personnel.
- 24X7 monitoring and awareness campaigns will be conducted with community participation.

Uniform Civil Code:

 We will create a Uniform Civil Code Committee to prepare an implementation roadmap to bring in the Uniform Civil Code across the state of Telangana. A Committee of experts will be set-up to examine the relevant laws regulating personal civil matters of the residents of Telangana and to prepare draft law/laws or suggest changes in existing laws on the subject that includes marriage, divorce, property rights, succession/inheritance, adoption, maintenance, custody and guardianship. Government will bring in a law that will prohibit the practice of polygamy and polyandry amongst public servants.

Grooming:

 BJP on assuming office will take adequate measures to control the increasing cases of targeted Grooming by creating robust mechanisms at a community level both in villages and cities. The perpetrators of grooming will be meted out with severe punishment.

Issue of Ration cards:

 We will give new ration cards to all the eligible families. Further, we will periodically issue new ration cards and provide easy options to register online or at ration shops at any point of time.

Quality Ration:

 Ensure that quality of ration is provided through PDS by a fool-proof mechanism that ensures prevention of diversion of the food grains.



Housing for all:

The BJP, on assuming office, will construct houses for all homeless leveraging the funds allocated under P M A was Y o jana programme The current Government has not availed of the PMAY-Garmin to benefit the rural homeless and BJP on assuming office will leverage the rural housing scheme.

House Site Pattas for the poor:

 House site Pattas will be given to the eligible poor in rural areas.

Support for house construction:

 We will provide incentives for those building houses on their own land.

Farmer Welfare

Fertiliser to Farmers:

- In spite of the skyrocketing international prices of fertilisers, the Modi Government has been providing over Rs. 18,000 in the form of fertiliser subsidies per acre.
- As a result, farmers pay a nominal price upto Rs. 4,000 per year per acre on Fertilisers (Rs. 267 per bag of Urea and Rs. 1,311 per bag of DAP).
- We will provide ₹2,500/- as input assistance to small and marginal farmers to enable them to procure seeds and fertilisers.
- This will especially benefit farmers who are actual cultivators of crops. Thus, tenant farmers will be the ones who will benefit immensely from this intervention.

Free Crop Insurance:

• The state government will implement Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana in the state and will also pay the premium for farmers under the Fasal Bima Yojana. It will also extend additional support in case of crop losses due to factors such as excessive rains, drought, or unfavourable weather conditions. Specifically in the event of crop loss, whether due to excessive rains, inadequate rainfall, or adverse weather, the government will provide compensation as per scale of finance with a minimum of Rs. 15,000 to affected farmers.



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MSP Bonus:

- We will provide Rs. 3,100 MSP on paddy to ensure that farmers get maximum benefits.
- A reasonable bonus above MSP will also be provided to Millet farmers of Jowar, Bajra, Korra and Ragi to promote the cultivation of Millets in line with the Prime Minister's agenda.
- We will procure Minor Forest Produce from all willing tribals at MSP.

Market Intervention Fund:

 We will introduce a market intervention fund to provide justice to farmers of forturmeric.

Market Opportunities for Farmers:

 We will introduce a market intervention fund to provide justice to farmers of for turmeric.

Mechanisation Support:

 Farmers will be incentivised on the acquisition of drip irrigation systems, implants, tractors and other mechanised equipment including drones.

50% Seed subsidy:

 We are dedicated to enacting specialised legislation to take stringent measures against counterfeit seeds. Furthermore, our government will actively distribute high-quality seeds with a substantial 50% subsidy.

Seed banks:

 "Traditional Seed Banks" will be established to preserve and distribute traditional paddy and millet grains to organic farmers at subsidised rates.

Agriculture Supply Chains:

 We will develop agriculture supply chains – Modernise agriculture market yards, cold storages, paddy warehouses, fruits and vegetables processing centres, meat (sheep and goat) processing centres, sorting, and grading units, primary processing centres to benefit farmers of the state.

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Cold Storages and Godowns:

 We pledge to construct godowns or cold storage facilities tailored to the local agricultural needs, and entrust their management to farmer groups by forming village clusters.

Organic and Natural Farming Policy:

 A new dedicated policy for Organic and Natural Farming that is specific to the needs and suitability of the state, especially for horticulture, vegetables and spices will be formulated. A specific Telangana branded Organic Shops/Stores will be established to trade Organic Produce and ensure remunerative market prices are realised.

Rythu Samriddhi Kendras:

 We will set up Rythu Samriddhi Kendras, one in every Gram Panchayat as a one-stop centre for all agricultural needs of the farmers, on the lines of PM Kisan Samriddhi Kendras.

Essential inputs and services for farmers:

 We will fill up all 800 vacancies of Agriculture Extension Officers positions to bridge the knowledge and technology gap in farming.

Shree Anna Processing Centres and Outlets:

- We will establish 4 Shree Anna Processing Centres in Khammam, Warangal, Asifabad and Bhupalpally to double millet exports by 2028.
- We will set up 50 dedicated Shree Anna outlets in all major urban centres for selling and promoting millet-based products.

Promotion of Traditional Beverages:

 We will promote Ragi Ambali, a millet-based traditional drink, as the state drink of Telangana.

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Cotton Specific Interventions:

- We will facilitate the setting up of new cotton ginning mills by providing subsidised loans with the aim of doubling cotton processing capacity.
- We will launch the Cotton
 P i n k B o I I W o r m
 Management Mission to equip cotton farmers with technology and resources against pest attacks.

First Turmeric City of Telangana:

- We will develop a first-ofits-kind Nizamabad Turmeric City, leveraging on PM Sri Narendra Modi's announcement on the formation of a National Turmeric Board, by establishing state-of-theart processing centres and export promotion units to make Nizamabad the biggest turmeric value chain cluster in India
- We will strive for a GI tag for the Armoor variety turmeric of Telangana.

Establishment of Processing Centres, Clusters and Food Parks:

- Palm: We will notify oil palm cultivation zones and initiate setting up processing units in the clusters of Khammam, Kottagudem and Suryapet.
- Chillies: We will set up chilli storage and processing units in old Warangal and Khammam districts with an aim to double chilli export.
- We will ensure Warangal Teja Chilli, also known as Chatpata Chilli, is given a GI tag.
- We will establish 3 new Mega Food Parks for chillies in Warangal, soyabean in Adilabad, and fruits and vegetables in Rangareddy districts.
- Mango: We will promote 3
 Mango Food Chain Clusters
 in Nagarkurnool,
 Khammamand Jagtial.

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Accessible and Affordable Travel for Farmers:

 We will introduce special feeder buses, Rythu Vahanalu, from every gram panchayat to the nearest urban markets to facilitate affordable transportation of horticulture produce.


Mission Bathukamma:

 We will launch the Mission Bathukamma to double flower cultivation in

- Telangana and increase the income avenues of farmers.
- We will set up Flower Processing Centers in Rangareddy, Nalgonda, Warangal and Khammam, to tap into flower-based products markets.

Welfare of Podu Farmers:

 We will resolve the Podu lands issue and allocate pattasto all Podu farmers.





Animal Husbandry

District Level Cooperative Dairy Farms:

 To foster the growth of the dairy sector, we will promote Cooperative Dairy Farms in every district.

Co-operative brand for value addition:

 Dairy Producers will be facilitated to sell value added dairy products such as ghee, curd, milk-shakes under a co-operative brand.

Indigenous breeds:

 Leveraging the Government of India's Rashtriya Gokul Mission, we will give subsidies for production of indigenous breeds.

Holistic Livestock Policy for Goat and Sheep rearing:

 To ensure that the farmers rearing livestock are getting remunerative prices, all necessary support will be provided.

Development of Inland Fisheries:

 We will develop Telangana as an inland fisheries hub of India by setting up 10 Inland Fisheries Clusters in Krishna and Godavari river basins, equipped with processing and marketing units.

Boosting Sericulture:

 We will launch Telangana Silk Samagra, a comprehensive sericulture policy, to significantly increase the annual silk output of Telangana.

Increasing Apiculture:

 We will provide subsidy for training in honey making under the National Beekeeping and Honey Mission and will develop Honey Corridors in Vikarabad, Adilabad and Nalgonda.

Mandal Level Veterinary Clinics:

 We will a establish state-ofthe-art veterinary clinic in every Mandal to ensure a c c e s s i b l e a n i m a l healthcare.



Mahila Shakti -Women Led Development

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Free laptops for College going girls:

 Free laptops will be provided for girl students who are entering undergraduate degree or professional college coursess.

Interest-free loans for Self Help Groups (SHG):

- We will give interest-free loans to empower those Women SHGs (like DWCRA Communities) with good credit history/ratings and foster their economic growth.
- DWCRA women will also benefit from a 5 lakh insurance policy.

Separate SHG Brand:

 Adequate training and marketing support will be provided to women selfhelp groups to produce various items and market these items under a separate SHG brand.

Ujjwala beneficiaries:

 The government is committed to providing 4 free gas cylinders per year to every Ujjwala beneficiary.

Women safety:

 We will expand the presence of all-women police stations and strengthen laws to enhance the protection of women in our society.

10 Lakh new jobs for women:

 We will create 10 lakh new jobs for women in government and nongovernment sectors in 5 years.

Aada Bidda Barosa (Benefit for the new born Girl Child):

 Government will pay premium for the newborn girl child so that they will receive Rs. 1 Lakh at the end of 18 years and an additional Rs 1 Lakh at the end of 21 years.

Mahila Rythu Corporation:


Interface with the Private sector:

Enhanced Budgetary allocations:

 The BJP Government in Telangana will ensure that the Education budget will be increased commensurate with the needs of the state and there will be shortage of funds for infrastructure and salaries.

Implementing the National Education Policy:

 The Government of India's New National Education Policy will be implemented in its entirety and roll-out timelines will be adhered to

Gross Enrolment in School Education:

 We will strive to ensure that Gross Enrolment Ratio will be 100% in all districts

Gross Enrolment Ratio in Higher education:

 We will work to increase the gross enrolment ratio (GER) of higher education in the State from 36% to 50% in the next 5 years through structured incentives, fee reimbursements and encouraging women enrolment.

Recognising traditional Universities of Telangana:

• In recognition of the contribution of Universities in the Telangana agitation and the role of the students, the BJP on assumption of office, would unleash this energy by creating a one time grant for enhancing in frastructure and recurring grant for research to Osmania University and all other State Universities.

- Quality of teaching methodologies shall be continuously monitored and regular training will be provided so that they can leverage new technologies while imparting education.
- Smart classrooms will be enabled by facilitating digital education tools in all Government schools
- Syllabus will be enriched and upgraded on par with CBSE syllabus focusing on skill development.

Nodal Schools:

- On assumption of office, the BJP promises to set-up a nodal school for each mandal which will have good facilities which will be available to students and teachers of all other schools

Leveraging GoI funds for Hostels:

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Doctors:

 We will improve facilities in PHCs by ensuring the availability of doctors and support staff. We will ensure that a General Practitioner is available in all PHCs and Basti Dawakhanas.

Medicines:

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Transparency in Corporate Hospitals:

 BJP is committed to bring out transparency in corporate hospitals in an effort to curb complaints about overcharging.

Combating anaemia especially among women:

 A v a ilability of Nutraceuticals to combat anaemia and other medical conditions that commonly ail pregnant women as a part of Anganwadis through ASHA workers. Also cast iron cooking equipment will be provided free of cost for pregnant women.

The BJP will give a dedicated thrust to infrastructure in the state. We will adopt a HIRA Model of focus on Highways, Infoways, Railways and Airways in Telangana.

Telangana

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Expedite pending road and rail projects:

 Pending state share and land acquisitions will be completed on missionmode in all Government of India projects ensuring the execution of 4,000 Kilometres of Roads and 1,300 kilometres of Railway lines in Telangana.

Regional Ring Road and Outer Ring Rail:

 Support Government of India's infrastructure push by expediting land acquisition for the Regional Ring Road and Outer Ring Rail Project.

Pending Metro Rail project:

 BJP, on assumption of office will expedite the Hyderabad Metro Project in the Old City region that has been pending due to political pressure.

UDAN Airports in Telangana:

 Work with Government of India and support the UDAN Scheme's effort to enhance connectivity by expediting the operationalisation of the airports of Mamanoor, Adilabad and Jakranpally.

Gramin, Mandal and Rural Roads:

 A comprehensive road development plan will be unveiled by constructing pucca roads connecting mandal headquarters and rural areas.

Dry port:

 Leveraging on the PM Gati Shakti initiative, dry port with multi-modal logistics park will be developed on a public-private-partnership in suitable locations within the state.

Sustainable construction:

 Create a plan to build roads out of the waste of single use plastics and other materials to encourage the circular economy.



Electricity Sector Green Telangana, Clean Telangana Powering Telangana's Development

Reducing Telangana's Power Bill:

• We will enable Telangana consumers to become smart consumers through energy efficient devices and demandres and making electricity consumers a part of the digital revolution of the Power sector. To ensure this we will distribute LED bulbs and BLDC Fans to every ration card holder at heavily subsidised rates to emphasise energy conservation.

Improving financial health of Power sector:

 The financial health of the DISCOMs has had a ripple effect on the upstream power value chain of TRANSCOs and GENCOs. Out of 51 DISCOMs across

- India, Telangana DISCOMs are ranked at 43 and 47.
- The BJP, on assuming office, will do the following to improve the financial health of the power sector.

Transition to Green Energy:

- The BJP, if elected will do the following to ensure a more sustainable energy operating framework:
 - Enabling more green power generation by doubling the current installed capacity of Solar power in Telangana to 10,000 MW from the current ~5000 MW.
 - Barren lands will be utilised for Solar power generation by installing solar panels.
 - Solar Power for houses s c h e m e w i l l b e implemented with 30% subsidy provided by the Central Government.
 - Solar Panels will be installed on the rooftops of all Government offices,

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- municipality and Panchayat offices.
- Leverage the Green Hydrogen Mission incentives.

Electric Vehicle Ecosystem:

- BJP, on assumption of office, will bring more electric vehicles (2-wheeler, 3-wheeler and 4-wheelers) onto the grid and make them smart consumers and reduce air pollution:
 - Incentivise existing apartment complexes, Gated communities and commercial Properties to set-up EV charging infrastructure.
 - Integrate set-up of EV charging infrastructure into new building plans as a part of approval process.
 - Mandate Green delivery in last-mile delivery ecosystem such as Swiggy, Zomato and Amazon etc.

Farmers as Electricity Producers and Entrepreneurs:

- Farmers, cooperatives and FPOs will be incentivized to set-up solar energy-based power plants of capacity 500 kW to 2 MW through e x i s t i n g U n i o n Government's PM KUSUM Scheme and with top-up s u b s i d y from state government.
- Individual farmers will also be supported to switch to install solar Agriculture pumps by increasing the state subsidy share from 30% to 50%. Farmers will only need to pay for 20% of the cost for switching.

Virtual Power Plants and Net metering:

 We will bring in fresh policies such as Virtual power plants to enable households to generate and sell power generated from solar power to the grid and to offset their consumption and reduce their electricity bills.

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Sand Mining Policy:

 Strict actions will be taken against those who are involved in illegal sand mining under the guise of government projects and against the officials who are helping illegal sand mining. We will bring a New Sand Mining Policy to prevent the erosion of riverbeds.

Other Illegal Mining:

 BJP, on assumption of office, will create a sustainable mining policy and will curtail illegal black granite and other forms of mining.



Water Tribunal:

 Govt. of India has issued a gazette notification by giving new terms of reference under section-3

- of Interstate River Water Disputes Act (ISRWD) of 1956 to Krishna Water Disputes Tribunal (KWDT-II) to reallocate the waters of Krishna River between Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.
- We will take all possible measures to represent the case of Telangana legitimately in front of the KWDT-II to get the rightful share of River Krishna waters to Telangana.

Safety of Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation:

• With the recent findings of National Dam Safety Authority (NDSA) on the technical flaws in Kaleshwaram project (Medigadda, Annaram and Sundilla barrages), we will take necessary steps in consultation with the Central Water Commission (CWC) to ensure maximum benefits to the farmers and also to the people of the state at large with minimal financial burden to the state exchequer.

Effective Utilisation of Godavari Rivers:

 We will ensure prudent utilisation of the River Godavari waters by constructing series of dams/barrages on River Godavari with step-ladder approach thereby turning the whole river into a reservoir. We will work on facilitating navigation for sea going vessels into the land locked Telangana on River Godavari.

Pending and New Irrigation Projects:

 We will complete all the pending projects on River Krishna (including their uncompleted 'command area development' under these projects) and also construct new projects on River Krishna to properly utilise the additional water contemplated from the tribunal for the drought prone areas of South Telangana.

Interlinking of rivers:

 We will interlink the Godavari and Krishna as per the National Plan.

Conserving Groundwater Levels:

 We will come up with a comprehensive plan to increase groundwater levels. We will prepare and implement irrigation and drinking water security plans at three levels village, mandal and district, by accounting for both surface water and groundwater resources.

Eco-friendly development of Hyderabad:

 We will ensure the ecofriendly development of H y d e r a b a d b y c o m p r e h e n s i v e l y rejuvenating Musi River and bringing the river back to its natural state including removing pollutants, cleaning up riverbed, restoring the natural environment around the river and reviving the rural economy that is dependent on this river. We will also implement a comprehensive plan to restore the diminishing tanks, ponds and river bodies in and around Hyderabad city, implement holistic plans to ease out the stormwater drainage issues plaguing the city.

100% access to drinking water for all:

 We will saturate the Har Ghar Jal Mission to ensure that clean potable drinking water by tap is available across the state.

Complete overhaul of Mission Bhagiratha:

 Existing poor quality construction in Mission Bhagiratha is leading to frequent pipeline damages and leakages in drinking water supply. This will be repaired on priority across the state.



We will focus on a comprehensive and all round development of the Greater Hyderabad region with respect to mobility, transportation, sewerage, drains, inundation, roads and traffic management in due recognition of the existing inconveniences faced by residents of the city.

All round development of Hyderabad:

 We will work towards transforming Hyderabad into a truly cosmopolitan city with quality all-weather roads, adequate sewerage and drainage and all round development across the city rather than a few pockets.

Identification and immediate relief to waterlogging prone colonies:

 Rirelief will be provided to those colonies that are

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waterlogging. Such colonies will be identified based on past records and several measures including construction of proper drainages and bunds will be done.

Regular maintenance of drains:

 In due cognisance of many deaths due to open drains, we will ensure desilting of drains will be initiated using modern technologies such as CCTV Drain Surveys and Jet Vacuuming to stop manual scavenging.

Simplify Property Tax assessments:

 We will simplify property tax Assessments so that Property tax can be paid easily and the GHMC can be strengthened financially by recovering pending dues.

Integrated Building Approval:

 A single window system will be brought into the state for getting clearances, licences and approvals for construction of buildings including mandates for Electronic Vehicle charging, Solar panels and rainwater harvesting.

Solid Waste Management:

- The Jawahar Nagar trash dump that stands at 614 Metres above Sea Level (MSL) shows the challenges in processing 7,000 metric tonnes of waste per day that is getting generated. To combat this Solid waste management projects will be implemented in the state completely with the following elements:
 - Segregate waste at source
 - Door to door collection of waste
 - Strategy to Recycle and Reuse
 - Waste to Energy Plants
 - Decentralised disposal of waste

Sewage Treatment Plants:

 Sewage treatment plants will be established in all Municipal Corporations cities to ensure 100% treatment of waste and prevent contamination of water bodies.

Affordable and reliable Urban Mobility:

 We will rationalise RTC Bus, Metro rail and MMTS Ticket charges to ensure affordable travel for all and at the same time ensure that these services are regular and reliable and in the process contribute to ease in traffic and road congestion.





Heritage, Legacy, Culture and History

Resetting the Narrative of Telangana's History

- Under the Qutub Shahi and even more so in the later Nizam rule, Telangana culture, Telangana identity, and the Telangana language of Telugu, were subjected to tremendous marginalisation. The Union Governmeinterest tont's decision to celebrate Hyderabad Liberation Day has led to opposition parties, driven by the politics of minority appeasement, to hatch a conspiracy to undermine the importance of the Liberation.
- The current dispensation is officially celebrating September 17th as Hyderabad Integration Day. The usage of the term "integration" instead of "liberation" was done to portray this historic event on par with the integration of 562 other princely states when in reality the efforts

- taken by Sardar Patel in liberating Hyderabad were substantially more and included the use of armed forces.
- This therefore undermines the valour, courage and sacrifice of the martyrs who fought relentlessly for the liberation of Telangana. This decision also undermines the efforts made by Sardar Patel in securing the liberation of Telangana.

Memorial and museum and Hyderabad Liberation Day:

 BJP, on assumption of office, in Telangana promises to build a memorial and museum to ensure that the struggle and sacrifices made during the liberation of Hyderabad are given due recognition.

Holistic celebration of Hyderabad Liberation Day:

 We will ensure that the Hyderabad Liberation Day will be commemorated officially on September 17th. Celebrations will be held across districts with arts, crafts and cultural elements

to revisit the timelines and engage the youth to know more about the sacrifices made during that time. We will also include the history of Liberation of Hyderabad in the school syllabi.

Yearly commemorations of leaders:

The contributions of leaders such as Sarvai Papanna Goud, Ramji Gond, Komram Bheem, Vande Mataram Ramachandra Rao, Swami Ramanand Teertha, Doddi Komurayya, Krishnaswamy Mudiraj, Konda Laxman Bapuji, Shoebullah Khan and many others who fought against the tyranny and oppression of occupation forces including the Nizam will be disseminated widely.

Razakars Horrors Remembrance day:

 We will observe August 27th as Razakars Horrors Remembrance Day in the lines of 'Partition Horrors Remembrance Day' declared by the Prime Minister to pay homage to the martyrs of Bairanpally and Parkal.



We will promote the diverse cultural heritage of Telangana and reinforce our cultural and spiritual traditions that have brought us together. To this effect, the following will be done.

Rejuvenating Temple Amenities:

- BJP will encourage rejuvenation of temples across the state.
- We will develop Sri Ramabhadra Corridor as a first in Telangana to transform pilgrims' experience of the Bhadrachalam temple town.
- We will renovate prominent temples like Mallanna temple (Komuruvelli),

Kurumurthy temple (Devarakadra), Aadi Jambhava mutt (Kolanupaka), Matha Manikeshwari temple (Narayanpet) and Chenna Keshava Swamy temple (Gangapuram).

Theme based Tourism Destinations:

- We will promote thematic tourism on the lines of the Swadesh Darshan Scheme.
- Fort Circuit: Warangal Fort, Rachakonda Fort, Golkonda Fort, Nizamabad Fort, and Domakonda Fort.
- Eco-Tourism Circuit: Along the eastern side of Telangana encompassing the Kawal Wildlife Sanctuary (WLS), Bhupalpally WLS, Kinnerasani WLS, and Amrabad WLS.
- Riverine Circuit: Krishna and Godavari River circuits along major irrigation projects.

MICE Tourism in Telangana:

 We will promote MICE tourism by constructing five world-class Kakatiya Convention Centres in Warangal, Karimnagar, K h a m m a m , Mahabubnagar and Nizamabad with state-ofthe-art facilities for business travel.

Archaka Salaries:

 The Dhupa Deepa Naivedya scheme is currently implemented in about 7,000 temples across Telangana where archakas are paid a salary of Rs. 10,000 and funds provided for daily prayers. This will be extended to all other temples across the state Archakas.

Telangana Samskruta Mahotsavam:

We will conduct Kakatiya
 Utsavalu in all the districts
 of Telangana to celebrate
 the contribution of the
 Kakatiyas in the tangible
 and intangible cultural
 domains including special
 funds to promote Perini

Natyam, Burrakatha, Oggu katha, etc.

New Performing Arts Centres:

 We will set up 4 Nataraja Ramakrishna Centres for Performing Arts in Warangal, Nizamabad, N a l g o n d a , a n d Mahabubnagar to promote theatre, dance, music, folk art etc.

Telangana Janapadam:

 A special Center in each district to promote Telangana folklore and local traditions and integrate the m with new technologies so that they continue to be patronised by the youth and upcoming generations.

Pensions for Folk artists:

 Pension and Hand-holding of various traditional artists and folk artists that include but are not limited to Yakshaganam, Perini Sivatandavam, Oggu Katha, Dappu and other artists.

Elevating Sammakka-Sarakka to a national level

- The mother and daughter of Sammakka and Saralamma (commonly known as Sarakka) are believed to be manifestations of Adi Parashakti sent to protect the tribal communities of Telangana. In their honour, the Sammakka Sarakka Medaram Jathara is held once in 2 years in Medaram, Mulugu district, Telangana.
- Today, by virtue of them attaining divinity they are looked upon as Goddesses across Telangana. Within Telangana, Sammakka-Sarakka invokes a sense of devotion in the mind of every Hindu irrespective of caste and creed cutting across generations. Their acceptance and following transcends caste and community barriers across the Hindu community.
- We will completely transform the Sammakka.

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- A complete ban on cow slaughter will be implemented in the state as per Article 48 of the Constitution of India. To ensure its implementation, the following will be done:
 - Government will encourage Goshalas, Bull breeders and Desi cowdairy farms, etc.
 - Any willing farmer who wishes to possess a cow shall be provided a healthy milk-yielding cow in tie-up with local Goshalas based on availability.
 - Establish an institution including Gau Shalas at such places as may be deemed necessary for taking care of the cattle to be sent thereto.
 - Offenders found guilty will attract punishment


with imprisonment not less than three years but may be extended to seven years or with a minimum fine of fifty thousand rupees per cattle but which may extend to five lakh rupees or with both through an act similar to The Karnataka Prevention of Slaughter and Preservation of Cattle Act, 2020).











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
